Police Defence Tactics trainers, as well as Police Close Protection / Armed Response trainers and Special Operations Terrorist) trainers. Andy has taught Self Defence courses for over 38 years, for a number of organization.

### Background

#### The ICM

#### Pre-Course

The pre-learning theory element is required to be covered prior to attending the training day. This can be done by completing the online elearning or by reading through a workbook. A theory assessment must also be completed prior to attending the practical course. This enables you to take the theory in at your own pace, as well as providing you with a good foundation for what will be covered during the practical sessions.

As mentioned earlier, the principles and concepts are based around your role (i.e. If you are Police or Security) or civilian and act as a bolt on to any pre existing training and preferences.
